

## Notes on Removing the K12LT Side Panels

- Pop off the side mirror
- Remove the wind deflector (3 screws)
- Remove the indicator lens - unplug the bulb
- Remove the crash bar cover - 1 screw at rear (just in front of your foot); 1 screw underneath at front; 1 screw underneath in center; 2 allen screws securing black trim underneath;
- Open glove box; remove 2 allen screws securing small center cover (in front of seat).
- Remove this cover (slide down/back and lift out).
- Raise the driver seat.
- Working clockwise on left hand side of bike remove the following screws:
  - screw immediately under rider seat on top rim
  - screw in center (was under cover plate)
  - screw 'in' glove compartment
  - screw under mirror
  - screws in indicator light recess (x2)
  - screws along bottom (x3)
- The rear of the panel is plugged into a large rubber grommet (directly under the rider seat mid-panel) - unplug this gently
- Holding the front and the rear of the panel gently wiggle it UPWARDS first then out towards you. There is a small locator tab on the side panel next to the glove compartment that is used as a locator in a slot in the radio cover. Be sure not to bend this when replacing the cover.

The install is just the reverse of the above, taking care not to bend the locator tab.
